Pride@K&K

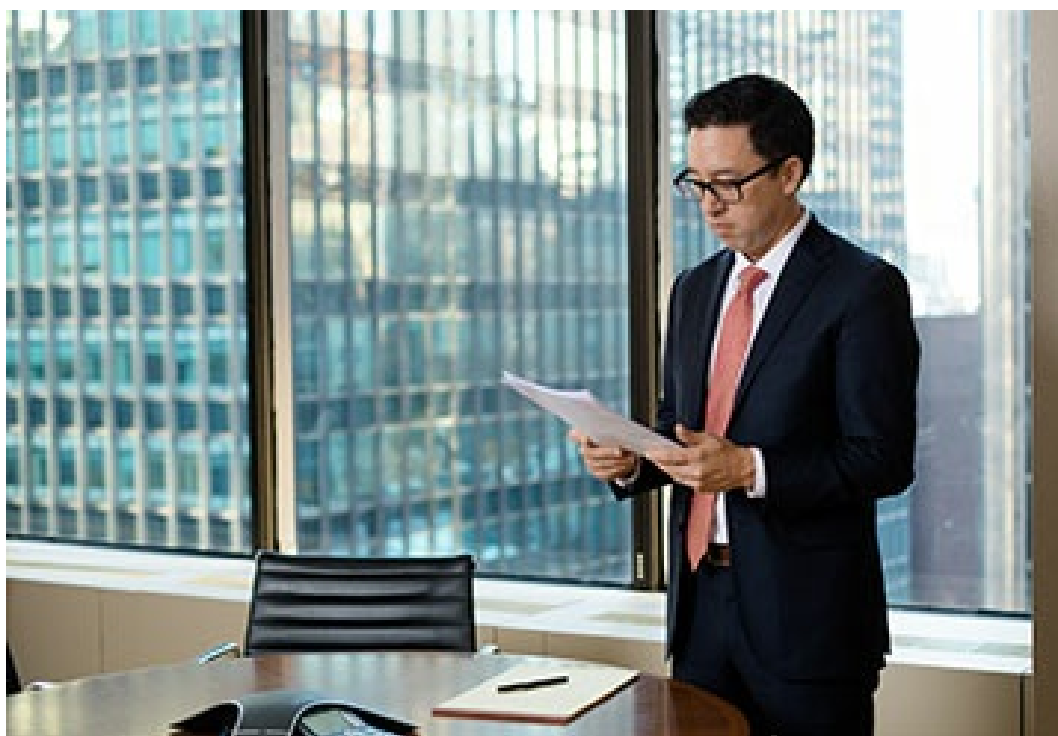
