The U.S. regulatory environment is more complex and less forgiving, and companies are expected to be fully transparent and cooperative with regulators.”* He also highlights the importance of selecting advisers who can bridge Israeli and U.S. legal and commercial norms while providing pragmatic, growth-oriented guidance.

The feature underscores New York’s continued relevance for Israeli companies, and the need for careful planning when entering one of the world’s most active commercial jurisdictions.
