Chambers Asia-Pacific 2018 Recognizes Kobre & Kim With Top Rankings for Work Related to China

Chambers Asia-Pacific has recognized Kobre & Kim and three of the firm's lawyers for their strong reputation in China for **Corporate Investigations/Anti-Corruption, Dispute Resolution: Litigation** and **Restructuring/Insolvency**.

For Corporate Investigations/Anticorruption (International Firms) — China, *Chambers Asia-Pacific* lauded the firm as "renowned for its personalized service and discreet approach to highly sensitive matters."
