Alexandria Swette on How AI Tools May Impact Attorney-Client Privilege

Kobre & Kim's Alexandria Swette was quoted in a recent Reuters article examining the implications of artificial intelligence tools on attorney-client privilege. In the article, she cautioned: *"We are telling our clients: You should proceed with caution here,"* highlighting the potential risks that communications with AI platforms may not be protected and could be subject to discovery.

The coverage follows a recent court ruling raising questions about whether AI chatbot interactions are privileged, underscoring growing legal and regulatory scrutiny around the use of AI in sensitive communications.
