The Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC) has announced that it has filed a civil complaint against Benjamin Sauter and David McGill for allegedly defaming the CFTC.

The complaint alleges that Sauter and McGill published a series of articles on the website [Forkast News](#) that contained false and defamatory statements about the CFTC's regulatory authority and its role in the cryptocurrency market.

The CFTC stated that the articles contained "a series of false and defamatory statements" that were "intentionally and recklessly published" with the knowledge that they were false. The CFTC also stated that the articles caused significant harm to the CFTC's reputation and its ability to regulate the market.

The CFTC is seeking damages and an injunction against Sauter and McGill. The CFTC also stated that it is considering other actions against individuals and entities that engage in similar conduct.
